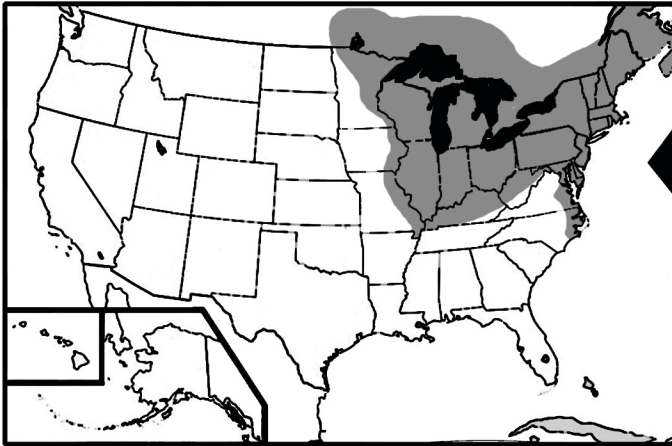

An area of North America where many Native communities shared the same kind of environment. Similar resources were available from village to village, and many customs and material culture were similar too. For example, houses in all Northeastern Native settlements were covered by bark and reed mats.
